### **ePortfolio: evidence via forms**

Students from Diagnostic Radiography on levels 2, 3 and 4 spend 13 weeks a year in clinical practice. For each of these weeks they are required to write a reflective account of an interesting, challenging, or new procedure that they have either participated in, or observed. The students are expected to support this account with evidence, which must be explicitly referred to in their writing. The additional evidence, obviously must be relevant, and there must be some sort of evidence in their writing to indicate that they have actually used it in their work and in their learning and development for the placement.

Compulsory quantitative elements are easy to record via the pro-forma that we give to the students and these elements, such as activity logs, are vital in a programme leading to professional accreditation.
