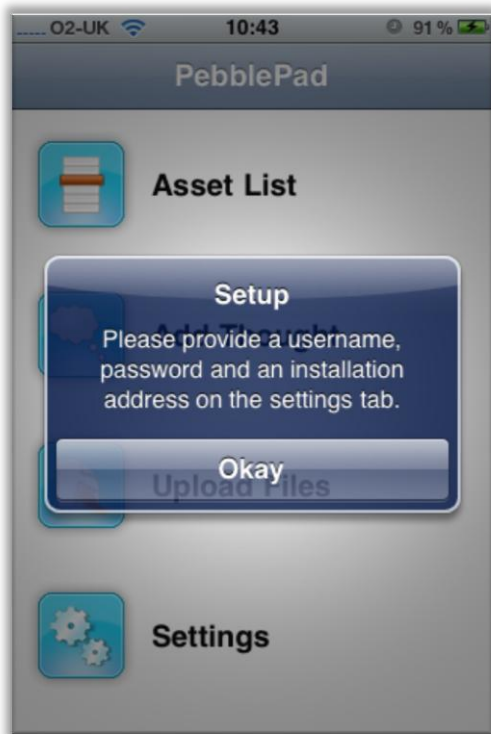


PebblePad iPhone Tipsheet V1

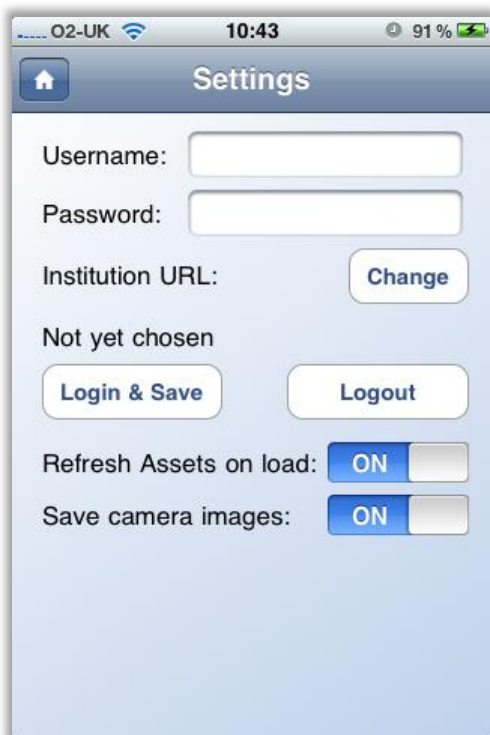
PebblePad iPhone Tipsheet V1	1
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Logging in

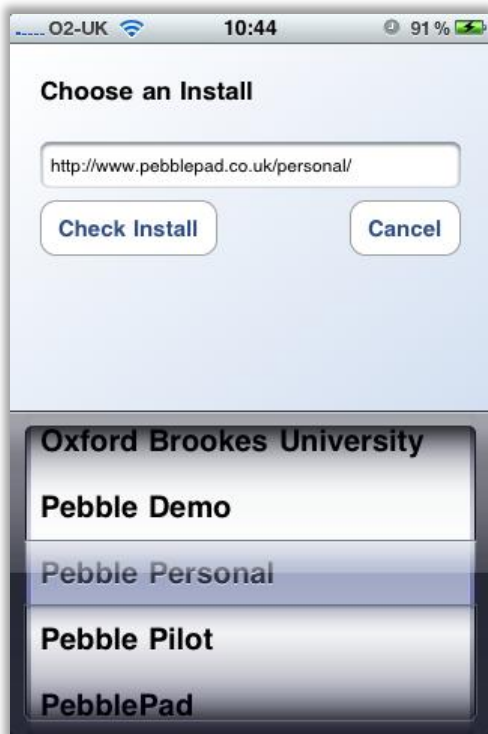
If this is the first time you've run the PebblePad app on your iPhone, you'll be prompted to login via the settings tab.



Dismiss the login prompt by touching the okay button then click on "Settings" to load the settings section.

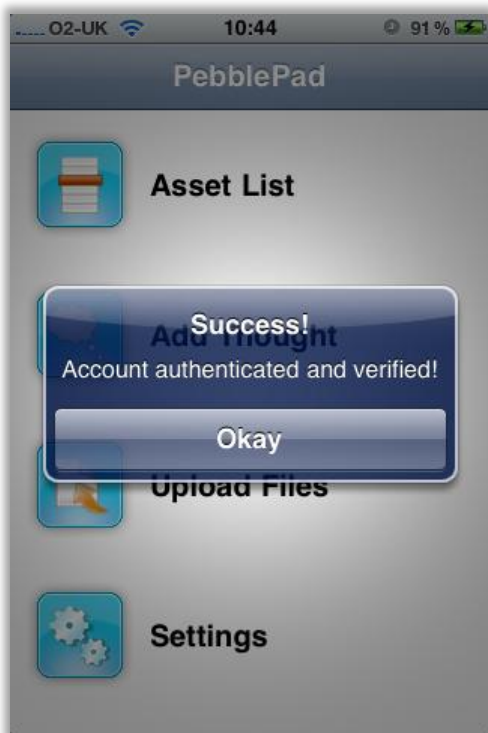


To login, type in your username and password (both are case sensitive) and touch the "Change" button next to the institution URL to bring up the institution picker.



Select your institution via the list, or if your institution is not listed then input the URL you use to login to PebblePad. To verify the address, touch on "Check Install".

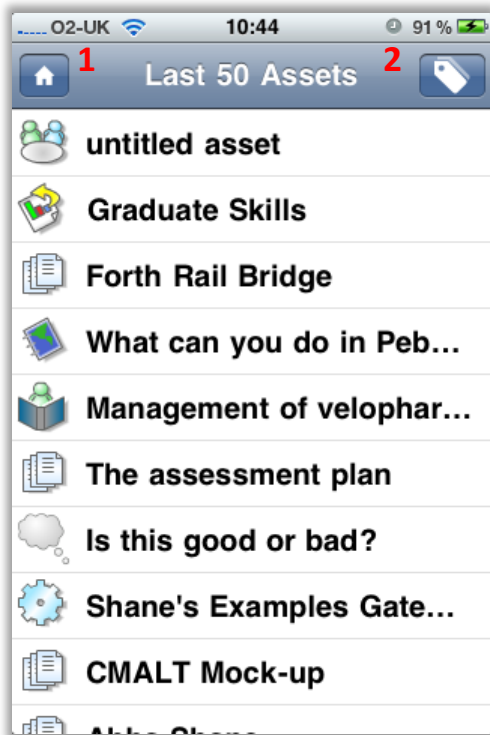
The institution must be using version 2.4.3 of PebblePad or higher. This can be found by logging into PebblePad and hovering over "Welcome back to PebblePad" or alternatively you can contact us at support@pebblelearning.co.uk.



After the address is verified, you will be returned to the settings page. Touch on "Login & Save" To test your credentials. After successfully logging in, you will be prompted and returned to the main menu screen.

If your details are not verified, please input your details again taking care to type in the correct case. You may also be required to login to your PebblePad account at least once via a web browser if you haven't previously done so.

Viewing Assets

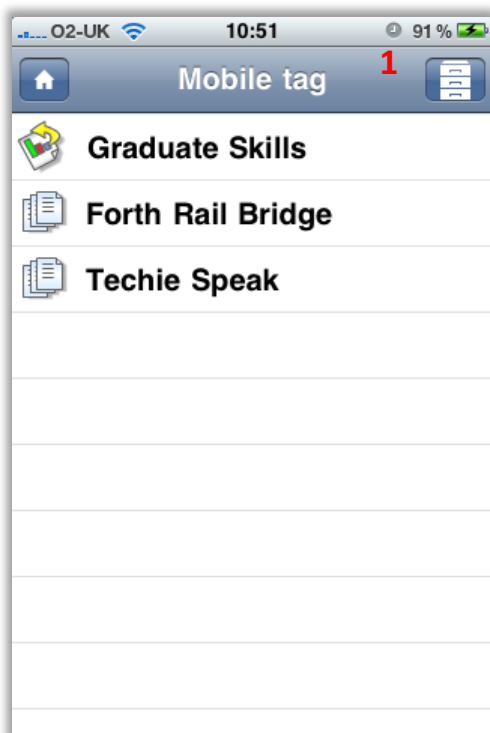


To view your assets, touch the "Asset List" icon or text. By default, your last 50 assets are shown.

Depending on your settings, the list may not auto update. To manually refresh your asset list, touch the screen and pull down to scroll the list upwards to reveal the refresh button.

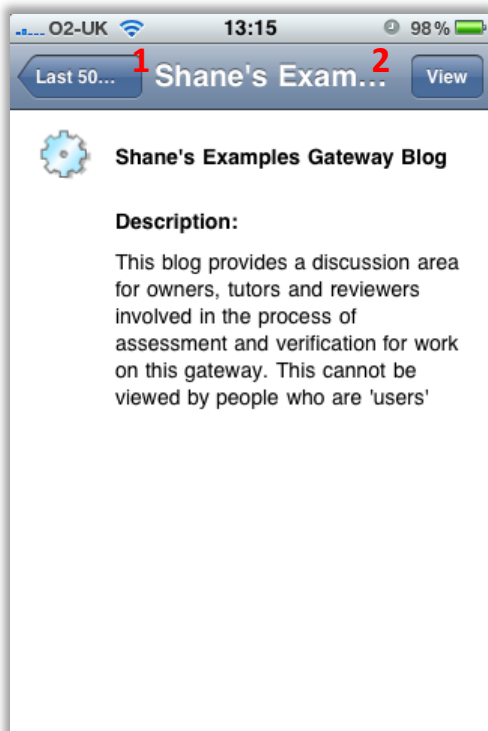
Touching button 1 will take you back to the home menu.

Touching button 2 will show you all assets in your account tagged with "mobile" as seen in the next screenshot.



Touching the "mobile" tag icon as discussed above replaces the list of the last 50 assets with any assets tagged as mobile in your account.

Touching button 1 will change the list back to the default list of the last 50 assets.



Touching one of the assets in the list opens the details page which shows you the title and description for that asset.

Touching button 1 will take you back to the list of assets.

Touching button 2 will allow you to view the asset.



Touching the view button shows the HTML view of the asset which can be zoomed and panned around in the normal manner.

Touching button 1 will reload the current page.

Touching button 2 will return you back to the asset details page.

Adding a Thought



To add a thought, choose "Add Thought" from the main menu. Type in a title for your thought and a description.

If you wish to post your thought to one of your blogs, touch the "Choose Blog" button.

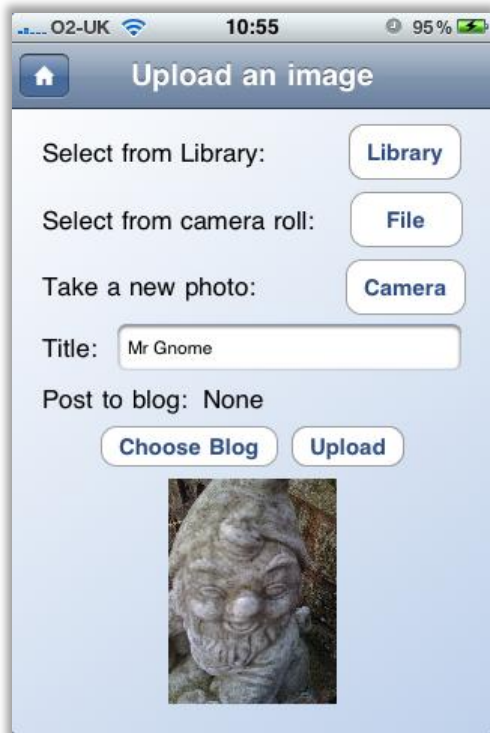


After touching "Choose Blog" a list of all the blogs you have access to will be listed. Select one from the list, or choose "None" if you wish to clear the currently selected blog and touch the "Done" button to return to the add thought page.



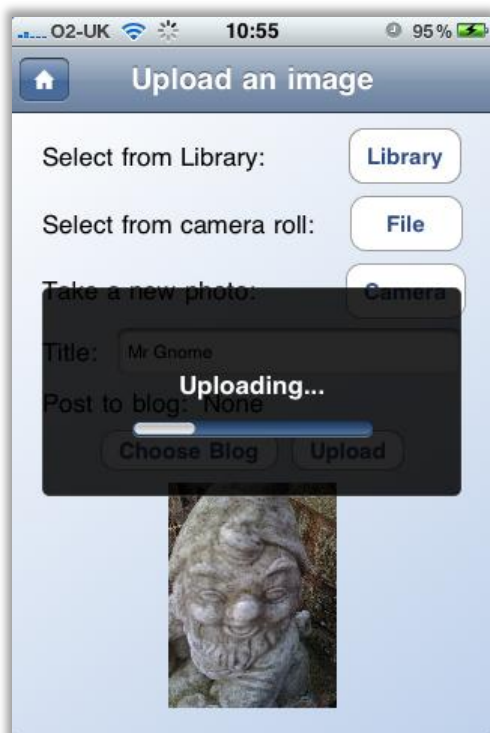
When you're ready to save, touch the "Save thought" button to add the asset to your asset store.

Uploading an Image



To upload an image, choose the "Upload image" from the main menu. Select your image to upload using the standard tools by touching either of the 3 buttons called Library, File and Camera.

After selecting your image, you can then add a title for your upload. If you wish, you can also publish the image directly to a blog (see the add thought section for details).

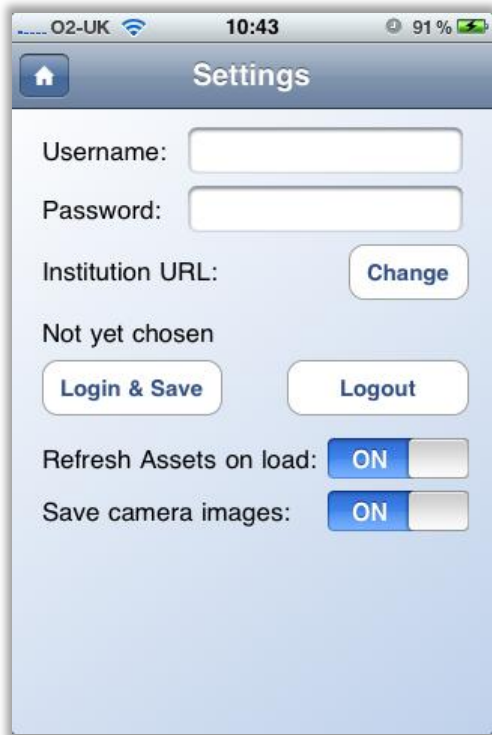


To begin the upload, touch on the upload button. Depending on the speed of your internet connection, this may take several minutes. Please be patient.



When the image is done uploading, you will see the following prompt.

Changing Settings



To access the application settings touch the "Settings" section on the main menu.

For information on the username, password and institution URL sections please see "Logging In" in this document.

The logout button gives you the ability to remove any stored authentication information. You'll be prompted if you're sure you wish to remove authentication before the information is removed.

The Refresh assets on load setting allows you to choose whether the view asset list automatically refreshes on first load. This is set to ON by default.

Save camera images allows you to choose whether images you take with the camera via the upload section are stored into the iPhone's camera roll. The default for this setting is ON.
