

Online Module Selection Facility: Postgraduate Programmes

A programme structure is a list of modules that you will undertake during your period of study.

Depending on what degree you are studying you may have some choice in what modules you undertake or no choice at all.

If you are a part time student you must undertake modules between a minimum value of 15 credits and a maximum of 90 credits in any academic year. Some Postgraduate Programmes have modules that must be taken in a particular order; others may give you the freedom to choose the order in which you complete the modules. **Please refer to your programme structure.**
