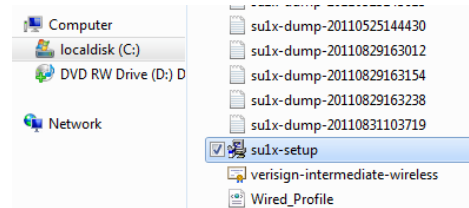


# Get Connected to Eduroam.

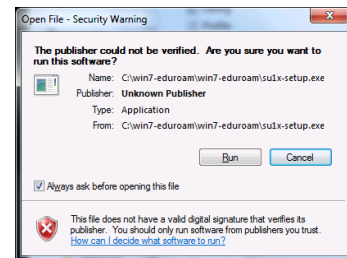
Eduroam provides a more secure method of connection to the wireless network. It also enables you to access the wireless networks of other Universities if they are a member. You will need a laptop/device with wireless enabled and a QMU account. For Windows vista and XP devices documentation see <http://www.qmu.ac.uk/it/eduroam/default.htm>. For windows 7 you can download a tool that will configure your laptop on the same page <http://www.qmu.ac.uk/it/eduroam/win7-eduroam.zip>.

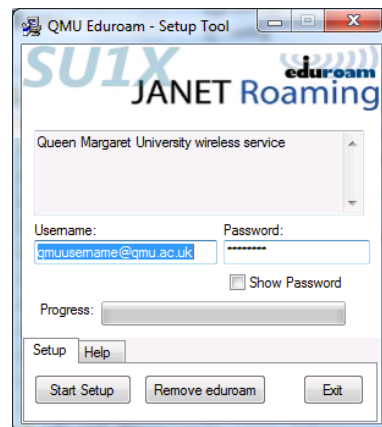
Save the file to your laptop and double click to expand. Then find the program su1x-setup.exe and run it .



If you get a security warning select Run



At the next screen enter your username [username@qmu.ac.uk](mailto:username@qmu.ac.uk) and then your password. Select the "start setup" button.



Once finished another window should appear like the one shown, select finish and then exit the setup tool window. If you get a warning saying the setup tool may not have installed properly just select yes.
