STTI and Developing Honor Society Membership Criteria

As documented in the 2015-2017 international bylaws

Undergraduate students must:

- have completed half of the nursing curriculum.
- achieve academic excellence. (At schools where a 4.0 grade point average system is used, this equates to a 3.0 or higher.)
- rank in the upper 35th percentile of the graduating class.
- meet the expectation of academic integrity.

Registered nurse students must:

- have completed 12 credit hours at their current school.
- have completed half of the nursing curriculum.
- achieve academic excellence. (At schools where a 4.0 grade point average system is used, this equates to a 3.0 or higher.)
- rank in the upper 35th percentile of the graduating class.
- meet the expectation of academic integrity.

Graduate students (master's and doctorate) must*:

- have completed one-quarter of the nursing curriculum;
- achieve academic excellence. (At schools where a 4.0 grade point average system is used, this equates to a 3.5 or higher.)
- meet the expectation of academic integrity.

*Students in graduate programs who are registered nurses, are legally recognized to practice in their country, and have a minimum of a baccalaureate degree or the equivalent in any field shall be eligible to be considered as a nurse leader at any point in the program.

Nurse Leader candidates must:

- be legally recognized to practice nursing in their country.
- have a minimum of a baccalaureate degree or the equivalent in any field.
- demonstrate achievement in nursing.
